**Reports:**

Mayor – Mayor Joy read the emergency services report for March 05, and reminded Council of the upcoming anniversary of Rose Fire Department and the Rose Fire Co. Business Show. He advised Council the SRPC is considering purchasing an unmarked police cruiser in 2005. Mayor Joy noted this could be utilized in traffic enforcement. He also noted the part time office has resigned, and advertisement has been placed in the newspaper. He requested the office look into a parking problem at the Railroad Alley along the pizza shop. The tenants of the apartments have been parking along the alley and blocking other traffic. The office will look into the matter and notify the police.

SYCRPC – D. Sarpen advised the Commission request the member municipalities send any requests for assistance to them in the upcoming months.

Web Site – W. Burgess requests all information for the web site be sent electronically, not hard copy.

Police – W. Cerkan noted the dept. has purchased a new copier and software. Shrewsbury borough is having an increase in calls due to false alarms, and is considering an ordinance to address the problem. W. Cerkan advised Council of an altercation in the Giant parking lot where an officer was injured during an attempted arrest.

Solicitor – S. Hovis advised he is waiting for the Trailview HOA documents, they are the only issue outstanding. S. Hovis advised he has another issue for executive session.

Citizens Forum – The NF Heritage Assoc. reported they will be having a mural painted on the side of Marlins Auto Center, and upcoming outdoor movie, a Volksmarch and a possible NF Festival.

Motion by G. Andrews, seconded by C. Herrmann to send a letter to Shrewsbury Twp. Advising NF would be interested in taking the portion of Masimore Road in the Twp. By annexiation. Motion carried.
