

**NEW FREEDOM BOROUGH COUNCIL MEETING**  
**February 20, 2008**

President Terrell continued the meeting from February 10, 2008.

**BUSINESS:**

Refuse Bids – President Terrell read the letter from Steve Stine concerning the bid results. York Waste Disposal submitted a letter indicating they have chosen not to submit a bid. Penn Waste, Inc. submitted a bid as follows:

2 Year \$ 647,010.00                      3 Year \$ 1,016,730.00

All bid requirements have been met by Penn Waste, Inc. Motion by J. Blum, seconded by W. Cerkan to award to Penn Waste, Inc. the bid for 2 years in the amount of \$ 647,010. Motion carried.

Police Trailer – T.L. Crawford explained the trailer in the parking lot owned by SRPC. President Terrell explained the need for the trailer to be stored permanently. T.L. Crawford inquired at the WWTP, which currently stores found bicycles and a former ambulance for the SRPC, and has no extra space for storage. Council discussed various possibilities, noting the Borough must also follow the Ordinances on storage. Council suggested another municipality may have a location that could be utilized. Motion by J. Blum, seconded E. Paules to notify the SRPC and Chief that the trailer may remain for 30 days for customizing the trailer, than must be relocated. Motion carried.
