Water Tank Removal Bids – President Terrell read the bids received on the removable of the 3rd St and Cemetery water tanks as follows:

Motion by J. Blum, seconded by D. Sarpen to award the bid to Allstate Tower, Inc. for the amount of \$ 76,325.71. Motion carried.
