BUSINESS:

T.L. Crawford advised the School Alley/Smith Mill/Hunt Run bids are as follows:

Fitz & Smith Inc. \$ 120, 360. and alternate #2 \$ 41,500.

T.L. Crawford explained the base bid includes School Alley reconstruction, portion of top lot and Smith Mill Rd. full depth reclamation and reconstruction, including Portland cement. Alternate # 2 is maximum 570 tons of wearing course material (9.5 mm mix) for Hunt Run Drive and misc. repairs and or patches. Motion by J. Blum seconded by L. O'Brien to award the base bid to Fitz & Smith, Inc. in the amount of \$ 120,360. with alternate # 2 in the amount of \$ 41,500. a NTE total of \$ 161,860. Motion carried. President Terrell advised the adjoining property owners will be sent an invitation to a meeting with the engineer and contractor to learn the scope of the project.
